ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday is the start of the Lenten season. It is also a day of fasting. This day has been celebrated in the Christian church for approximately 1,000 years and is a day when all Christians are called to examine our lives in the light of God's love and forgiveness.

The ashes used on Ash Wednesday are meant to represent dust. When receiving ashes on our foreheads, we share the words, "Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return." This is a reference to what God says to Adam when exiling him from the Garden of Eden.

In the Psalms, David passionately reflects on how powerful God's love and mercy are when he writes, "For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust. The life of mortals is like grass, they flourish like a flower of the field; the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more. But from everlasting to everlasting the LORD's love is with those who fear him..."

This year we will observe Ash Wednesday with a service of worship on Wednesday, March 2nd @ 6:30 p.m. Everyone is invited and encouraged to join together in person or online as we take up the Lenten journey together with God and each other. Let us hear together, in both body and Spirit, God's call to all of us to a season and a life of love, humility and faith.

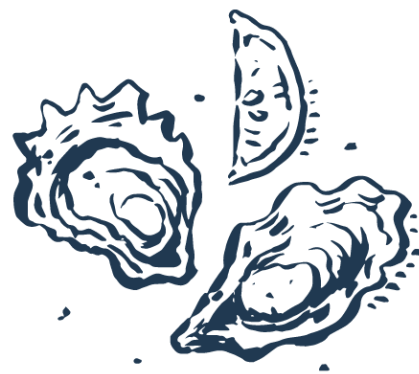
