Oyster Roast tickets will be available for purchase Sunday, February 5th through Monday, February 20th.

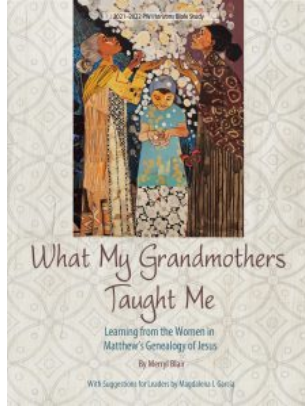
Ticket prices are:

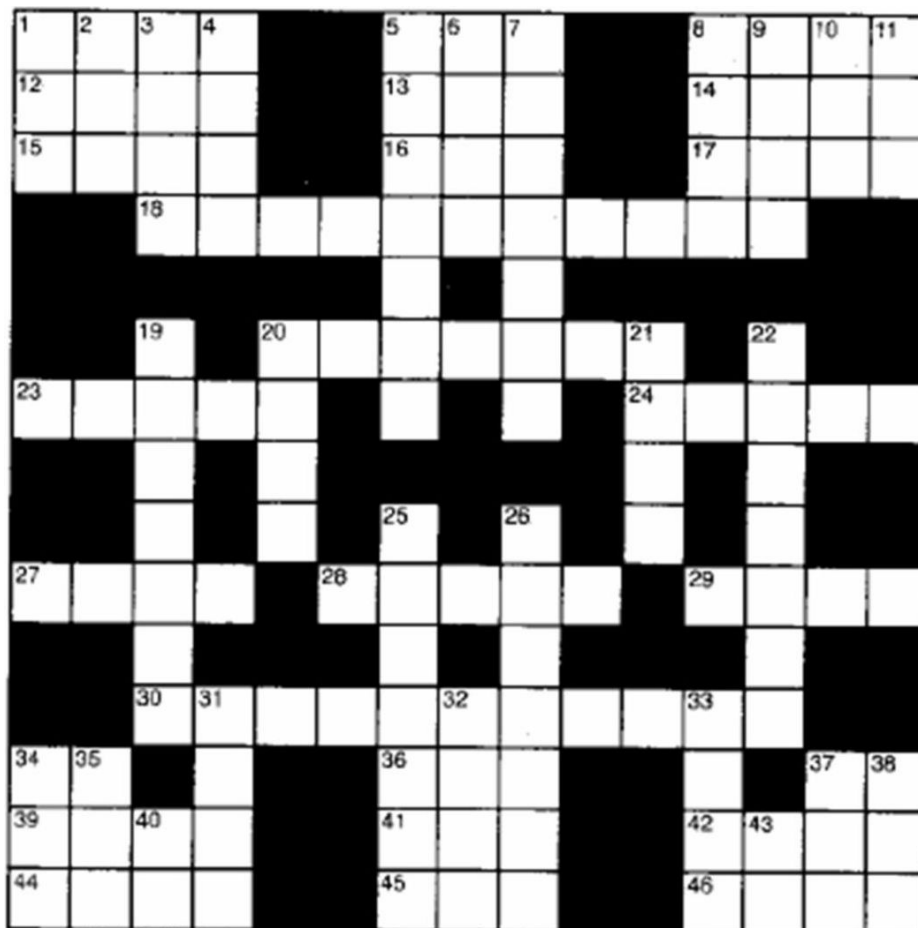
