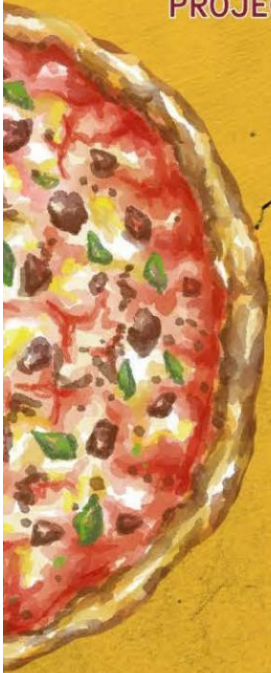

Please volunteer with us for our build day with Habitat for Humanity. We will be helping with a new home build for Kristin on Saturday May 20th, 8 a.m.-noon.

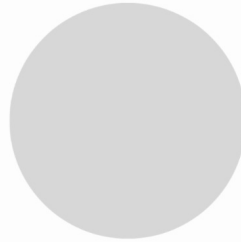

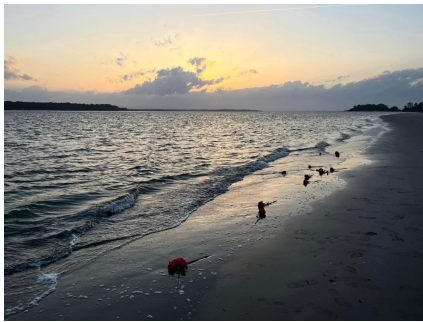
