November 15 • 6pm



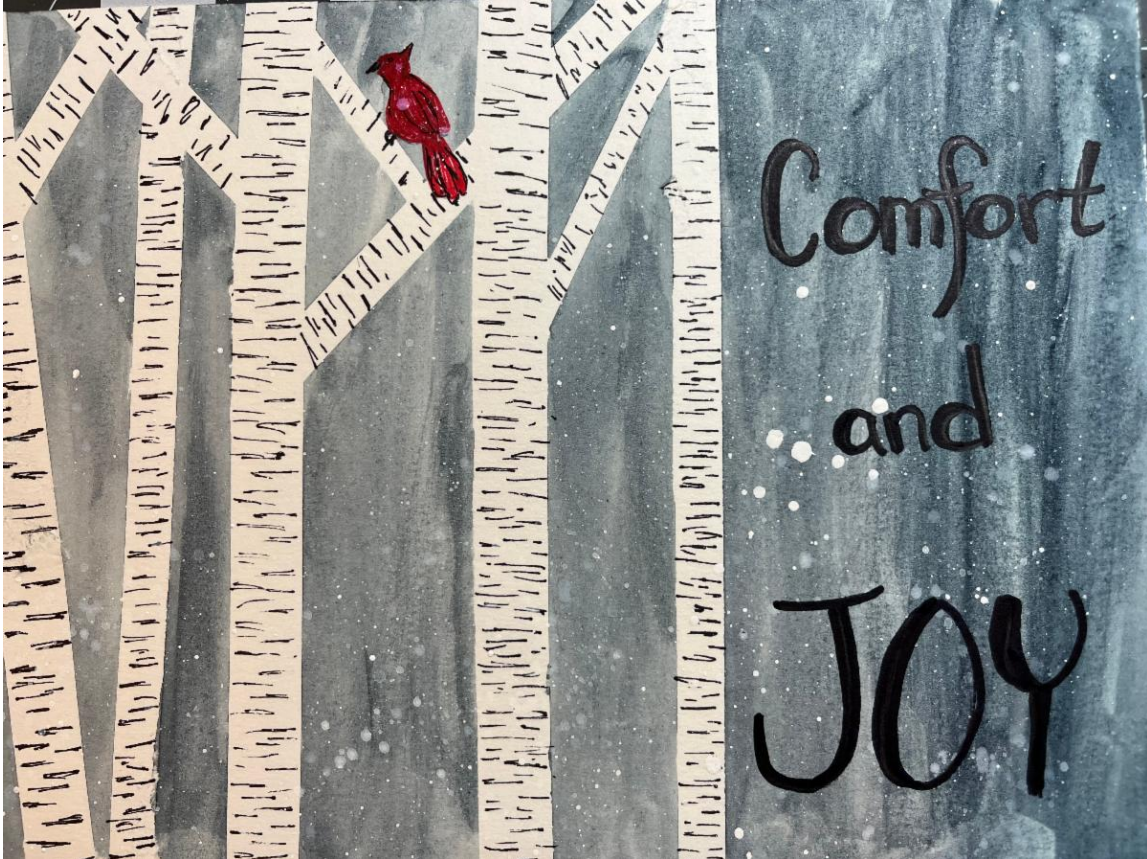
Join us for special evening of food and fellowship as we learn about the ministry of Remember Niger Coalition.
