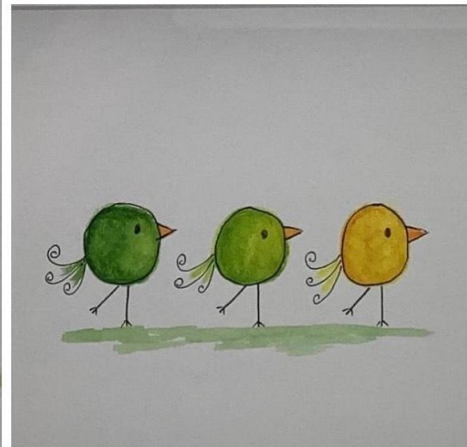
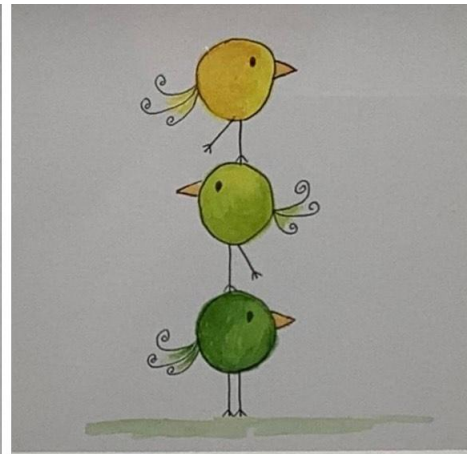
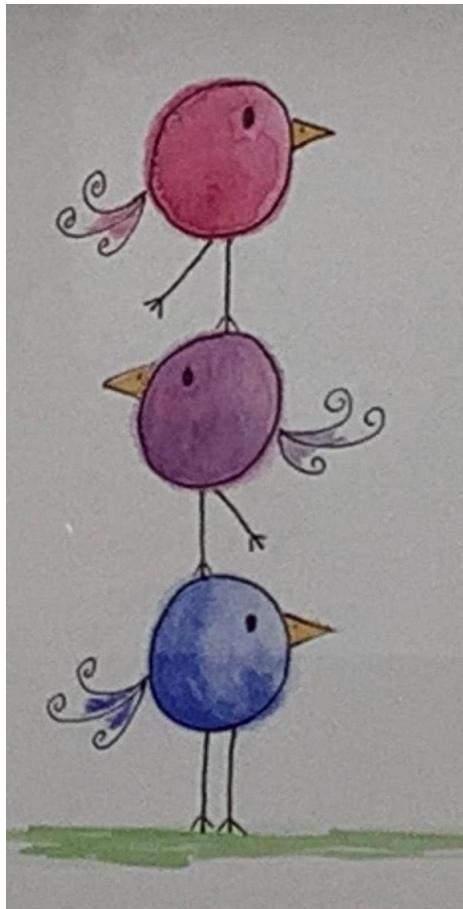

Bring "cash and a can" to the service on Sunday, February 11th and join the national movement looking to fight hunger and poverty right in our own communities!

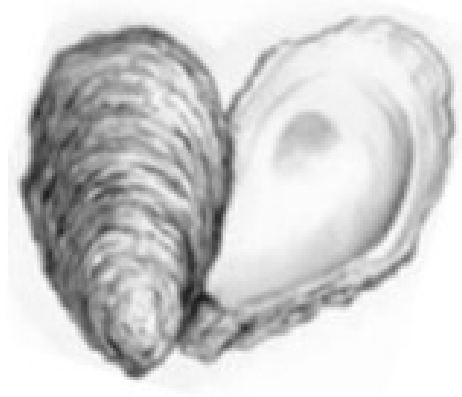

### **James Island Outreach Update**

This past year HVPC provided food, supplies, and volunteer service to JIO. Our Jiffy Corn Bread Mix and other food items totaled 2,224 pounds. That is amazing. Our Volunteer Team provided many hours of support in the pantry the second Tuesday every month in 2023. Each Tuesday involved 2 to 3 hours of time from each volunteer.

HPVC members have also been diligent in providing brown paper bags, plastic bags and egg cartons.

I learned that JIO uses over 3,000 brown paper bags per month. The volunteers have established a very efficient method of having the paper bags ready for clients each service day. The bags are actually doubled bagged - - a no-handle bag inside a bag with handles. This may seem trivial, but it provides a smooth process for clients and volunteers. The attached picture shows how the bags are packaged for easy retrieval. If your bags could be placed in the outside box in this method, it would eliminate volunteer time to sort the bags. Thank you for your consideration. Plastic bags are used for produce, but not as many are needed.

JIO is not receiving eggs from our previous provider; therefore, egg cartons are not being used and are not needed at this time. If that changes, we will certainly get the word out.

Many thanks for your continued support. JIO is providing amazing support to our community. There is a hard-working staff and so many dedicated volunteers. It is rewarding to be a part of this organization.
