The green paraments indicate we are back to "ordinary" time according to the Liturgical calendar. I guess that means the other six months of the year are "extraordinary" time... Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, and Pentecost.

We went to the beach on Memorial Day, and I realized God knows each one of the people on this beach. It was then I noticed a young man playing catch football with his dad. I first noticed how far he could throw the ball with his left hand and then noticed something else, his right arm was deformed and not the same as his left.

This turned out to be ironic as this week's scripture is from Mark 3:1-6, the story of a man with a withered hand that Jesus heals on the Sabbath.

I wish I could say "Stretch out your hand," to the young man and his hand would be healed. But we are in "ordinary" time, not "extraordinary time" when Jesus and the disciples were present and were able to heal the sick, blind, lame and paralyzed.

Later, a woman walked by on her phone that was obviously crying.

Here...on the beach, all God's people.

The only thing I could think of doing was to pray. Pray for the young man, the woman, and all the people on the beach that day for God's blessing.

"May the Lord bless you and keep you. May he lift his countenance to you and be gracious to you. May his face shine upon you and give you peace."

God hears our prayers. They don't have to be lengthy or wordy. He just wants us to be in communication with him.
