We will hold a joining event at a worship service in July or August once we know who will be participating.

We still need to build a committed team who will be involved with membership and promotion. This could include following up with lapsed members, reaching out to visitors, and brainstorming ways to promote our church within the community. It's very hard for a church to grow when no one is doing these important things in an organized way! If you're willing to give this team a try, please contact me. We definitely need to have this team in place before our next installed pastor arrives.
